**1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr S Swanson, Cllr Rolfe and Cllr Summerbell

**2. MINUTES**

The Minutes of the previous meeting of the Town Council have not been circulated. Therefore, these will be approved at the next Town Council meeting.

**3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Members were asked to declare any personal interest and the nature of that interest which they may have in any of the items under consideration at this meeting. **None were declared.**

**4. ON THE FUTURE OF THE ONE WAY SYSTEM.**

Cllr Coombs confirmed that members of the Town Council had met to review the video surveys produced by Bucks County Council. The video surveys were taken before and after the one-way system was introduced. Cllr Coombs provided a summary of the main differences from the two videos and that full data sheets of the findings would be made available in the Town Council office. Cllr Turner advised members that prior to the introduction of the one-way system, the town had 15 empty units, compared to today's 5 (with 1 pending to be filled). The video also highlighted an issue with inconsiderate parking in the town and that this needs addressed by Bucks County Council. Cllr Streule advised the members that the results from the public consultation carried out last year were pretty even and that the public were in favour of removing the cycle lane.

Cllr Streule proposed that based upon the findings from the surveys and the results of the consultation that Bucks County Council are informed by the Town Council that the one-way system is to be retained and to be made permanent. Seconded by Cllr Turner. A vote was taken with 9 in favour and 1 against (Cllr Bendyshe-Brown). Cllr Streule also proposed that the Town Council request a meeting with Bucks County Council asap to discuss the following: removal of the contra-flow cycle lane; introduction of short-term parking bays in Duke Street, extension of the bus stop area outside the George Hotel and the current enforcement levels for illegal and inconsiderate parking. Seconded by Cllr Turner. **All present agreed. (Cllr Williams left the meeting at 7.50pm)**

**5. ON CHOOSING THE TRUSTEES TO REPRESENT THE TOWN COUNCIL ON THE SOCIAL ENTERPRISE FOR THE DAY CENTRE.**

Cllr Turner proposed himself as a representative, seconded by Cllr Woolf. **All present agreed.**  
Cllr Coombs was proposed by Cllr Turner, seconded by Cllr Clifford. **All present agreed.**
